NEWS: Esco Williams, Stephen Langstaff and Anton Powers join forces for The CALM Love Triangle



Three of the best emerging talents from across the Liverpool music scene, will join forces to create a new piece of music, set to be streamed at **theCALMzone.net** on **Valentine's Day 2013**. The innovative **CALM** campaign includes 2012 MOBO Unsung AWARD winner **Esco Williams**, prolific songer/songwriter **Stephen Langstaff** and the legendary Liverpool-based DJ, record company boss and producer **Anton Powers** as music ambassadors.

The Calm Love Triangle has seen the campaign team up Bido Lito! Magazine to bring the three artists together to create a new piece of music for Valentines Day 2013. Esco Williams and Steven Langstaff spent a day in the legendary Motor Museum studios (the studio of choice for Arctic Monkeys, Ben Howard and Tribes) with producer Al Groves to record the main body of the song. Anton Powers will then lend his remix expertise to the final cut of the track.

Over the past three weeks, a series of documentary videos from the recording sessions have been screened on the CALMzone.net, as each of the artists share their experiences of the project. Here they are:





Simon Howes, CALM's Merseyside co-ordinator says, "There is a lot of research to show men often don't have the support network that women do and so have less options to utilise when the are feeling alone or come out of a relationship.
